FAITH FORMATION LIVING and ONGOING LIVING PROGRAM of FAITH

Our 4 First Communicants will be joint the 14 other Faith Formation Students in the soon to arrive CONFIRMATION on June 9th, the Solemn Feast of Pentecost! Much more have to be done, weekend retreat for the teens and for the preteen a day of recollection. The retreats are not just essential part of preparation to the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation but indispensable in enabling the students to be truly open and prepared for such a wonderful Sacrament, a Sacrament that with the 7 fold Gifts will transform their lives to be life long disciples and witnesses to Jesus Christ.

This brings us to the importance not only of the parents but also all the sponsors of these students preparing for Confirmation. The sponsors are to be life long companions on the journey of Faith with their respective child.
