COMMUNITY CLEARINGHOUSE

Offers personal and household items to individuals and families in need and serves as a resource for homeless individuals seeking emergency sustenance and assistance.

READY TO LEARN

Helps students return to school with educational tools that will help them succeed in the classroom and continues to distribute school supplies year round while supplies last.

ADOPT A FAMILY

Matches low-income and homeless families with individual and corporate donors to fulfill holiday wishes.

EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

Provides financial assistance to people who are at risk of being homeless due to an unexpected emergency and helps others transition out of homelessness and into a permanent home.

BILINGUAL ACCESS LINE

Eliminates language barriers that prevent people from accessing basic necessities through spoken interpretation and written translation services.

SNAP OUTREACH

Connects individuals with benefits to ensure that the most vulnerable can access nutritious food.

REPRESENTATIVE PAYEE SERVICES

Provides money management services to individuals diagnosed with severe and persistent mental illness who receive benefits from the Social Security Administration.
